Uniform and Grooming

Just a wee reminder about grooming for dance classes.

It is a proven fact that students dance better when dressed correctly and hair is tidy.

Hair: Please can the children with long hair make sure they have their hair tied back at all lessons. Please can all students make sure their hair is tidy, and ponytails redone after school to tidy the straggly hair falling around the face. We do not expect ballet students rushing from school to 3.30 or 3.45 classes to have their hair is a bun but students in classes on Saturdays and weekdays from 4pm onwards should have their hair in a bun please.

Uniform: Ballet, Jazz, Contemporary and Musical Theatre have a uniform. We ask that these dancers do not wear sports attire to classes but the correct dance clothing please.

We do not mind tops being worn over leotards for warmth, but we ask that the tops blend or match the colour of the uniform with no patterns or big logos and that they are not too long and baggie. Anna Lee School of Dance T-shirts can be worn – a more fitted top is preferred for ballet classes.

Hip Hop students can wear mufti to class. I would be ideal if the children can change out of school uniforms, but we understand if time does not permit this if you are rushing from school pick-ups.

It is not advisable to wear dance shoes outside as they will get dirty and wear out faster. We ask that dance shoes being worn at the Papanui studio are not worn outside. The dirt and little stones that shoes pick up can ruin our expensive dance floor. Students need to change into their dance shoes once they are inside the building, please or wear slides / street shoes over the top when outside. Students wearing Hip Hop shoes to dance classes or outside of dance will need to clean the sole before wearing them in the studio please.

Socks can be worn in contemporary classes, but we ask that the students purchase nonslip/grip dance socks. Wearing normal socks (especially sweaty socks) on the wooden floors in our halls or on the studio floor is not hygienic as well as making the floor slippery and harder for other dancers who are dancing in shoes.

Loose fashion jewellery shouldn't be worn to class. Teachers may ask students to remove jewellery, so it is better to leave it at home. Stud earrings are acceptable. This is normal practice for sports and dance classes.

Second-hand Uniforms

We would like to hold a second-hand sale but at this stage we do not have much in our boxes. If you would like us to try and sell anything on your behalf, please can you get your items to us as soon as possible. All items need to be placed in a resealable bag. It is a good idea to pin or stick a name tag to each item in case it becomes separated from the bag. On the bag, please state your name and phone number and how much you would like for the item. You can also put your bank account details if you would like the payment this way rather than cash.

Reminders - especially for our pre-teens and teens 😊

We need parents to support us with the following and have a chat at home please.

- We ask that phones, tablets and iPad etc are not brought out of bags during classes.
- Students need to bring their drink bottles into the dance rooms, so they are not leaving class every time they need to have a drink as they tend to be taking longer and longer to come back into class.
- We ask that students do not leave the dance room unless needing the toilet or if feeling unwell.
- Students should always be respectful to their teachers and classmates. Social chat should be kept for before and after class

Exams and Medal Awards

Exams, Assessments and Medal Awards will be held in Term 3. These are not compulsory but give the students something to work towards.

NZAMD Medal Awards

ALSD Internal Medal Awards

- These will be offered to our younger dancers to help prepare them for external medal awards and future exams
- We do not have a date set yet but will have this confirmed as soon as we have more information about our external exam dates.

APDA Assessments and Exams

- These will be held in September. We will be given our actual dates once our entries have been submitted and processed by APDA
- Entries close May 18.
- Information and Entry forms will be emailed to eligible students before the end of this term.

RAD Class Awards and Exams

- Between September 8 11
- Entries close June 17
- We will contact those eligible with more information and the entry forms during term 2.
